Soon after her July 2019 surgery, Segler started care with April Shelly and the rest of EMH wound care team. Four months later, her incision is healed, and she is on the road to recovery.

April Shelley, Registered Nurse in charge of Infection Control at EMH, said Segler was great to work with and thinks their facilities were the best place for her due to the personal connections involved.

“We are always available; if you have any questions or concerns, you can always call and we will usually get you in the same day,” Shelley said.

Shelley said she has had patients come to her in the past due to long wait times at bigger hospitals and urgency of the care needed. Patients often have better experiences there, she said.

“I think the satisfaction of actually seeing progress and healing is the best part of what we do, on both sides, patient and provider,” Shelley said. “We do all aspects of wound care, from simple dressing, to very complex wound treatment, like non-healing surgical wounds.”

Segler said going to EMH wound care is like being around family. You get more one-on-one time with your provider, in comparison to larger care centers, so you know you are getting quality treatment and top-notch care, she said.

“It's more like being at home. It's that small town feeling that you belong,” she said. “You know it's family. You're not just another number.”

“They care about you,” she said.
