

Green Warrior Permaculture “Training Of The Trainer” Apprenticeship Program Launched

Green Warrior Permaculture, a collective of sustainability specialists, just launched an apprenticeship program that will be run through the new facilities at its Centre of Advanced Permaculture.

The incorporation of this training service aims to facilitate the expansion of the Green Warrior movement and to tackle the actual shortage of effective permaculture trainers.

Permaculture is the conscious design of agriculturally productive ecosystems that have the diversity, resilience, and stability of natural ecosystems. A permaculture teacher will be capable of training others on the integration of land, resources, people, and the environment to generate a no-waste, sustainable community anywhere in the world.

The “training of the trainer” apprenticeship program starts with a 10-week hands-on internship where the intern will be trained in all aspects of practical permaculture. From there the trainee will be mentored as a novice trainer and will learn from experienced permaculture practitioners. The program also includes lessons on teaching styles and techniques, as well as the opportunity to co-teach during permaculture workshops and courses.

The training program lasts a total of 2 years and following its completion the teacher will be qualified to open their own permaculture field school. The trainer will also qualify to continue co-teaching with the collective for a further 2 years. All permaculture knowledge will be acquired directly from sustainability experts and experienced teachers.

Green Warrior Permaculture has developed effective strategies for sustainability in permaculture aid work, recovery solutions for negatively impacted communities, and permanent food security programs around the world. Its founder, Steve Cran, is a permaculture aid worker with 20 years of field project experience. He has set up sustainability initiatives in war, post-disaster, and poverty zones and his aid helps the people of these areas rebuild their communities using local resources.

As the leading voice for the program, Steve Cran said “My current aim is to train the trainer and work with the youth. Our youth have been weakened by poor nutrition, low-quality education, and the oversupply of artificial information. Our hands-on training method restores the youth’s mind, body, and soul and gives them a toolbox to fix the world’s problems.”
