BASKETS AND DECOR

Using mostly plant-based materials, Rebecca Gaut of **Beam & Branch** handdyes lengths of cotton rope then weaves them into striped baskets accented with leather — no two are alike. *Find it: Barn 5400*

POTTERY

Looking at the vases and platters created by Forrest Lesch-Middelton of **FLM Ceramics**, you might think they hail from another time and place. Using image transfer techniques, he evokes the look of an ancient civilization. *Find it: FLM Ceramics studio*

JEWELRY

The seasonal collections of **Robindira Unsworth** can be found in boutiques worldwide, but Petaluma is her home base. Her statement pieces combine rustic silver and gold with one-of-akind stones.

LEATHER BAGS Under the label **Pennyroyal Design**, Jennifer Conner creates exquisite handmade leather bags. The midsize Dany bag, with its soft exterior and exaggerated buckle tail, is perfect for toting essentials in style, and a coin pouch becomes a conversation starter covered in black and white cowhide. *Find it: In the Making*

SOAP AND SKINCARE

Made with all-natural ingredients and packaged sustainably, the soap, shampoo, and body bars from **Three Sisters Apothecary** are feel-good luxury. They smell incredible, too: blood orange and cardamom, and Mission fig and honey. *Find it: Soap Cauldron*

BROOMS AND WHISKS

The humble broom is an heirloom piece in the hands of artist **Alissa Kaplan**. They're fully functional – but hand-tied, Shaker-style, with broomcorn, twine, and locally sourced black walnut, cottonwood, and willow, they're pretty enough to display. *Find it: Ziz Land*
