The Kennesaw FedEx Shooting: An Example of the Increasing Trend of Workplace Violence

[Occurrences of workplace violence are rising](#) at an alarming rate. The 2014 shooting at the FedEx facility in Kennesaw, Georgia is a noteworthy example of the most serious cases of workplace violence in the United States.

On April 29, 2014, [a FedEx package handler opened fire at the FedEx facility](#), wounding six people. The first person he shot was a 28-year-old veteran who was working at the facility as an unarmed security guard. The security guard's injuries nearly killed him and required him to undergo 54 surgeries over the course of the next three years.

The tragic incident occurred despite FedEx having experienced a previous active shooter event at another facility, knowing that another one could occur at the FedEx Kennesaw facility, and having received prior complaints about threatening conduct by the shooter.

Working on the injured security guard's behalf, _____ filed a premises liability lawsuit against FedEx for its lack of adequate security measures and equipment.

If an employee is injured as a result of workplace violence, their employer and any other entities involved in the incident might be liable for the employee's injuries. In many cases, the employer already knows or should know of the employee's violent tendencies before a more serious incident occurs. In the case of the FedEx Kennesaw shooting, for example, the shooter's aggressive behavior had been reported to management but ignored.
