Thanksgiving Day Biggest Day of Year for Fires

- If you do decide to use an oil fryer, cook outside away from walls or anything that may easily catch fire. Be sure to carefully follow the manufacturer’s instructions.
- Stay in the kitchen while food is cooking so that you are aware of any potential dangers.
- If you are using lit candles, keep them away from children, pets, curtains, or other flammable materials. Better yet, use flameless candles.
- Kids love to help with the proceedings, but it is best that they stay at least three feet away from the stove and oven in order to avoid potential burns and fires. Let them help in other ways.
- Keep towels, potholders, and other flammable materials away from the stove while cooking. Do not wear clothing with loose sleeves that may catch fire.
