The team here at [Eintracht] Frankfurt always plays with a high press. But if you're scoring a lot of goals, then the keeper also has to work a bit harder because the team doesn't play so defensively, right?

Yes, I would say that in the first half of the season we conceded a lot of chances; we played an attacking game, but of course defensively perhaps we let a few things slide.

I think I only kept a clean sheet twice in the first half of the season of the league which was incredibly frustrating and really wasn't great, but we are already doing a lot better on this in the second half of the season.

If you think that out of 14 [UEFA] Europa League games, we have seven clean sheets and we've kept a clean sheet in six out of the last seven games; we've come a long way in that regard.

We won 1-0 in Milan [against FC Internazionale Milano], we drew 0-0 at home [against them]; we won 1-0 against [1. FC] Nürnberg [I believe this was in the Bundesliga not Europa League]; it's once again proven that we can win 1-0 and don't always have to score two or three goals to win. So we've really improved on this in particular.

I think we're the third best team in the league in terms of goals conceded and for the second half of the season we're second after [RB] Leipzig who have also conceded very few goals. So, now, defensively we've improved a great deal, too.
