<< DIY JEWELLERY: RHINESTONE BROOCH & BEAD NECKLACE

Rhea Dhanbhora tries her hand at the popular rhinestone brooch and bead necklace and shows you how to recreate it at home



YOU WILL NEED: Beading wire, beads in the colour of your choice, a brooch, crimp beads, jump rings, a chain clasp, wire cutters, crimp pliers, round nosed and flat nosed pliers.



STEP 1

Attach your beading wire to a jump ring and secure it with a crimp bead and jump ring, using the crimp pliers and a flat nosed plier. String beads on to your wire, making sure to measure it to the length you want first. Repeat with three more strands, so you have four strands of beads.




STEP 2

Connect the jump rings at the end of the strands, two at a time, with another jump ring. Using your pliers, seal them shut and then knot the ends to hold them securely.



STEP 3

Attach the bottom jump rings to your brooch. You can attach them at an angle or straight. Play around with it depending on what style of necklace you want.



STEP 4

Connect a lobster clasp to one end of your necklace, tighten the jump rings, trim any loose ends and you're done! We suggest wearing it at an angle.
